There are 6 cabins that each provide bunkhouse style sleeping for 12 persons, with modern bathroom and shower facilities.

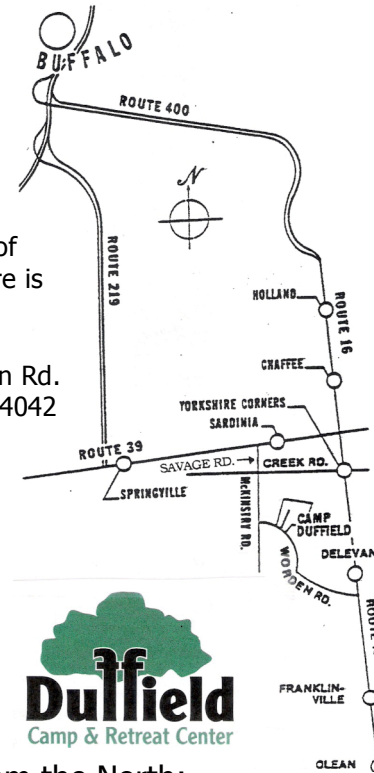
Outpost:

Tents on platforms gathered around a campfire and picnic pavilion, also with modern bathroom and shower facilities.

Most camps run from Sunday at 3pm until Saturday at Noon, with a few exceptions. Please let us know if you have any questions!
